

SAINT DAVID PREP SAFETY PLAN for PREP IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION

A. Responsibilities of the DRE, with the assistance of the St. David Parish Staff

1. All tables, chairs, and restrooms (toilets) will be cleaned and disinfected before each session.
2. Students will be seated SIX FEET APART during class.
3. The DRE and all Assistants will wear a FACE MASK when closer than six feet to students.
4. While teaching SIX FEET from students, Catechists may wear a FACE SHIELD, when assisting students (closer than six feet), they will wear a FACE MASK.
5. THE DRE will provide a zip lock baggie with a pencil, eraser, crayons, glue, scissors and a Rosary and Rosary pamphlet, to avoid distributing materials during class (*CDC recommended procedure*).
6. The DRE and Assistants will monitor the bathrooms as only one student may enter at a time and they must wash their hands before returning to class.
7. The DRE will notify parents immediately if she is informed that anyone present in their child(ren)'s session reports a positive Covid19 diagnosis.

B. Responsibilities of Parents and Students

1. Every student must always wear a FACE MASK (*arrival, during class and dismissal*).
2. Students must bring their Religion Text, folder and supplies in a schoolbag each week.
3. Your child's FULL NAME must be marked on all belongings.
4. Every student must bring a small bottle of hand sanitizer in a zip lock baggie to sanitize their hands before class begins. If parent's wish, students may bring disinfectant wipes (in a baggie) to re-clean their table space before class for added safety.
5. Parents must keep children home if they have a temperature over 100 degrees or are experiencing any symptoms of sickness (*chills, cough, shortness of breath, headache, body aches, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea*).
6. If a student tests positive for Covid19 and has attended a PREP session within a 14-day period of time, the parent/guardian must inform the DRE.

C. Arrival

1. FACE MASKS must be worn by everyone who enters Fr. Curran Hall until they are outside.
2. Students must enter by the main door and go immediately to their assigned seat.
3. When in their assigned seats, students must sanitize their hands and be ready for class.
4. If a parent wishes to enter with their young student, they must depart by either side door.

D. Dismissal

1. FACE MASKS must be worn by everyone who enters Fr. Curran Hall until they are outside.
2. The main door will be opened at 6:00 PM and 8:00 PM, for 10 parents to enter at a time.
3. The student and parent are asked to leave immediately by either side door.
4. Please do not stop to have a conversation until you are outside, as this will delay the parents who are waiting to enter to pick up their child(ren).

I have read the PREP SAFETY PLAN and agree to adhere to it and will remind my child(ren) to follow it.
